THE ENDGAME

Revolution's Nationals Group Finale for qualifying Showcase, Competitive, and Elite routines, held on the final day of Nationals.

THE ENDGAME: GROUP FINALE

QUALIFYING ROUTINES

Showcase, Competitive, and Elite group routines in Small Group, Large Group, Line, and Grand Line divisions.

Not included: solos, duo/trios, or 20 & Over / Adult routines — unless a 20 & Over routine is invited as a non-adjudicated special guest performance.

HOW INVITATIONS WORK

- Invitations are earned during Nationals qualifying rounds based on score, level, age, and category.
- Up to five top-scoring routines from different studios may be invited per division, with judges able to invite routines when warranted.
- Studios may qualify one routine per specific Endgame division, but multiple routines across different divisions.
- Invitations are non-transferable and are not replaced if a routine cannot perform.

SCORING

- The Endgame is a fresh competition; qualifying scores determine invitations only, while final placements are based solely on Endgame performances.
- Five judges score each routine, with the highest and lowest scores dropped.
- The judging panel changes from qualifying rounds to provide a fresh perspective.
- Excellence in Choreography and Excellence in Entertainment are selected exclusively from Endgame routines.



ENDGAME DIVISIONS + AWARDS

Awards may include Excellence in Choreography, Excellence in Entertainment, National Finalist Plaques, Crystals, National Champion titles, and Victory Cups where eligible.

SHOWCASE

11 & Under • 12 & Over

Group size does not separate Endgame divisions. Competes for Primary Crystals and Showcase National Champion. Not eligible for Victory Cups.

COMPETITIVE

Competes for Premiere Crystals and Competitive National Champion. Premiere Victory Cups: highest-scoring routines in 11 & Under and 12 & Over.

ELITE

Competes for Pinnacle Crystals and Elite National Champion

Victory Cups: highest-scoring routines in 8 & Under, 9–11, 12–14, 15–19, 11 & Under Grand Line, and 12 & Over Grand Line.

THE PRESTIGE recognizes the complete performer.

Competitive and Elite Title contestants can earn an invitation during Nationals qualifying competition and return to the stage for the National Title Competition.

Confidence. Composure. Command of the stage.

Personality. Authenticity. Connection.

COMPETITIVE | PREMIERE TITLE

PERFORMANCE | 100%

A new PRESTIGE performance score determines the results.

INTERVIEW | Not Scored

Meet the personality behind the performer. Not scored.

Competitive contestants do not participate in Presence & Poise.

Winners are crowned Premiere Mr. Revolution or Premiere Miss Revolution in their age division.

WHO CAN QUALIFY?

Dancers must be registered for Title during Nationals qualifying competition at the Competitive or Elite level. The PRESTIGE is invitation-only.

Up to three of the highest-scoring Title contestants in each age division may advance. Additional contestants may be invited at the judging panel's discretion.

CLEAN SLATE

Qualifying scores determine who advances - but do not carry into final PRESTIGE results. A portion of judging panel is replaced for The Prestige.

If an invited dancer cannot participate, the invitation is not replaced or transferred.

THE PRESTIGE GALA AFTERPARTY

Immediately following The PRESTIGE Awards, all Revolution Nationals dancers are invited to dress their best and celebrate with music, dancing and one unforgettable night before the final day of Nationals. *Free Admission Event*

WHAT IS THE PRESTIGE?

Revolution's National Title Competition, held exclusively at Nationals. It goes beyond a traditional solo competition to recognize performance, personality, confidence and stage presence - the complete Title performer.

HOW IS IT DIFFERENT FROM REGULAR NATIONALS?

Regular competition recognizes the highest-scoring performances. The PRESTIGE recognizes the complete performer. Competitive Title remains performance-based, while Elite contestants are scored in Performance, Presence & Poise and Interview.

WHAT IS PRESENCE & POISE?

A brief formalwear stage presentation for Elite contestants. It showcases confidence, composure and the ability to command the stage without choreography.

WHAT SHOULD ELITE CONTESTANTS WEAR?

Evening or formal attire that makes the dancer feel confident. This may include a dress or other formal evening attire for ladies, and a suit or comparable formal attire for gentlemen. Clothing itself is not scored.

HOW DOES THE INTERVIEW WORK?

Contestants participate in a brief live backstage interview before performing. Questions highlight personality and story - there is no single correct answer. Elite contestants are evaluated on age-appropriate communication, authenticity, connection, confidence and composure. Competitive interviews are not scored.

WHAT HAPPENS IF A DANCER CANNOT PARTICIPATE?

The PRESTIGE continues with the remaining invited contestants. Invitations are not replaced or transferred.

ARE SCORES ANNOUNCED AT AWARDS?

No. Results are announced as Second Runner-Up, First Runner-Up and Mr. or Miss Revolution for each respective Title division.

WHO CAN ATTEND THE GALA AFTERPARTY?

All participating Revolution Nationals dancers are invited. Dancers do not need to compete in The PRESTIGE to attend. The Gala begins immediately after The PRESTIGE Awards - dress your best for music, dancing and a final Nationals celebration.

Our opening number experience for select Elite level dancers ages 12 & over. Dancers will learn from an industry professional choreographer as they race against the clock to learn a full routine and perform it in time for the opening of The Endgame.

GRADUATION CEREMONY



Senior dancers are invited across the stage to receive their Revolution diploma and be celebrated by their studio, teachers, family, and friends as they close out their final season.

spirit day

Studios are encouraged to participate in the themed dress-up day and show their studio pride throughout the event. Spirit Day winners are selected by Revolution staff and receive a trophy and \$500 Star Dollars.

FREE MASTERCLASS NATIONALS
